Her subsequent executive roles across HSBC's Middle Eastern operations included CEO appointments in Jordan, Bahrain and Oman where she led business growth, implemented multi year transformation programmes and executed numerous M&A transactions. Alongside her executive career, she has contributed to sector wide development through board roles at the Oman Banking Association, Bahrain Association of Banks and Injaz Bahrain.
