In addition, he holds governance positions as Honorary Chair of the International Association of Public Transport (UITP), elected Chair of The Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce and Board Director of The Community Chest of Hong Kong.

Jacob's career at MTR spans over three decades, beginning in 1995 and progressing through management positions across Operations, Projects, and the Chinese Mainland and International Business Units. He was appointed CEO in 2019 and became a member of the Board at the same time. Prior to this, he served as Operations Director from 2011 to 2016 and subsequently as Managing Director – Operations and Mainland Business from 2016.
