Thomas Buberl is widely respected in global financial services, best known for leading one of the world's largest insurance groups through a period of strategic transformation, during which AXA's share price has nearly doubled over the past five years. He has served as CEO of AXA Group since 2016, overseeing operations in more than 50 countries. Under his leadership the group has been successfully repositioned from a traditional life insurer into a more agile, capital-light, and risk-diversified global player.

Thomas's leadership is defined by his ability to navigate complexity – simplifying structures, modernising systems, and driving performance in mature and emerging markets alike. Before becoming Group CEO, he was CEO of AXA Germany (2012-2015) and AXA Konzern AG (2012-2015), where he led a strategic realignment in a highly competitive and regulated market. He previously held executive roles at Zurich Insurance Group, including CEO of Zurich Switzerland (2008-2010), with responsibility for operational turnaround and customer innovation. He began his career at Boston Consulting Group in banking and insurance.

Thomas holds several influential non-executive roles. He sits on the Board of IBM, the global technology and consulting group listed on the S&P 100, and is a member of the Board of Trustees of the World Economic Forum. These roles reflect his broad strategic outlook and ongoing engagement in global conversations around digital infrastructure, corporate governance, and economic resilience.

Sustainability has formed a consistent thread in Thomas's strategic agenda – whether through AXA's early exit from coal-related investments, its leadership role in the Net-Zero Insurance Alliance, or the integration of ESG considerations into long-term capital deployment.
