Michael spent 27 years at Allianz before becoming CEO (2003-2015). He led a decisive turnaround that restored profitability and positioned the company as a global insurance and asset management leader. Taking the helm in the wake of the costly Dresdner Bank acquisition, he implemented sweeping cost reductions, refocused the business on core operations, and returned the group to profitability within a year. He also led Allianz's legal transformation into a European company (Societas Europaea), consolidated its European footprint, and oversaw strong international expansion.

He brings deep cross-sector expertise in:

- Insurance & asset management leadership – transforming Allianz into a global financial powerhouse with integrated operations and significant assets under management.
