Before this, he served as Hospital Director at Mediclinic City Hospital, where he oversaw key milestones including affiliation with Mohamed Bin Rashid University, establishment of the UAE's first private sector organ transplant and the development of a comprehensive cancer centre. His earlier experience also includes leadership roles at the University Hospital in Basel and within Mediclinic's European and Middle Eastern networks.

Through his executive, advisory and non executive roles, Christian has built a reputation for leading high performing, multicultural teams and enabling organisations to operate effectively in complex regulatory, financial and clinical environments. His work continues to focus on strengthening healthcare delivery, improving operational resilience and supporting sustainable growth across emerging and mature health systems.
